H'burg Airgas fill plant takes top honors

he Hattiesburg cylinder gas fill plant has been named National Plant of the Year by Airgas, an Air Liquide company. Selected from among 350 Airgas plants across the country, the Hattiesburg fill plant was the top performing fill plant in the South Division of the company, and surpassed other region leaders in safety and performance measures.

In 2016, the plant had no accidents for the second straight year and passed all compliance audits with near-perfect marks. The team of 22 plant operators and drivers – who fill and distribute cylinders of gases such as oxygen, nitrogen, argon, and helium to customers across Mississippi – produced around 21,000 high pressure cylinders per month, with one of the highest production and fulfillment rates in the South Division..
